WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by Article I, Section 2 of the

U.S. Constitution to conduct an accurate count of the population every ten years; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz received \$78.7 million in direct federal

funding in Fiscal Year 2017-18, an amount determined in part by census data; and

WHEREAS, census data also helps determine the apportionment of seats each

state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives and is used in the redistricting of

state legislatures, county boards of supervisors and city councils; and

WHEREAS, the decennial census is a huge undertaking that requires cross-

sector collaboration and partnership in order to achieve a complete and accurate count;

and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is facing several challenges with the 2020

Census, which include declining response rates, technological change, and fiscal

constraints, and support from local government is critical; and

WHEREAS, the City of Watsonville includes numerous recognized hard-to-count

populations, including seniors, immigrants including many migrant farmworkers,

students and more; and

WHEREAS, the County is inviting the Mayors of all local cities to join the Santa

Cruz County Complete Count Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Cruz County Complete Count Committee would consist of

a Steering Committee and six working groups; and
